FOCUS: COMMUNITY DIRECTION

Our second strategic outcome is that "People direct their services." When interdependence is a sign of a health community, we must listen-to and work-with one another to respond to each person's direction for their lives. We praise God for these communities that we have the opportunity to partner with, and pray for the wisdom to discern the best steps forward.

PRAYER POINTS

week three:

JUNE 16-22

THOUGHT: Life as a Christian does not require being tested on our Bible knowledge. We are called to notice what Jesus does and learn from Him. May we be especially mindful of how He might approach the situations that we face throughout this day.

PRAYER POINTS

- Please pray for stability in Haiti and Nicaragua as both countries continue to experience unrest
- Praise God for the end of another successful school year wrapping up in Haiti and Ethiopia, and for the increasing opportunities for people with disabilities to participate in school programs.
- Give thanks for all those who came out to Ryan's Rays on May 29th to support inclusive education in Ethiopia. Pray that these resources will make a significant difference in the communities and lives of people experiencing disabilities in Ethiopia.
- Pray for teacher training taking place over the next few months. These training opportunities help equip schools to include even more children with disabilities with their peers.

week four:

JUNE 23-29
