

Canada Student Grant for Persons with Permanent Disabilities

Who It's For:	Full or part-time students who have self-identified as having a permanent disability
Type of Aid:	Grant
Amount of Aid:	Up to \$2,000 per academic year.

Purpose

This grant assists students, who have self-identified as having a permanent disability, with their educational costs.

Amount of Aid

Up to \$2,000 per academic year

Who Can Get This Aid

Student enrolled in a full-time or part-time program who have self-identified as having a permanent disability. For the purposes of this grant, a permanent disability is defined as a functional limitation that is caused by a physical or mental impairment that restricts your ability to perform the daily activities necessary to participate in studies at a postsecondary level or in the labour force, and that is expected to remain with you for your life.
